QuEBS 2016 PRE CONFERENCE ZULULAND TOUR

Depart from conference venue to see a spectacular array of wildlife in a game reserves in Zululand – hopefully see the big five and more. This tour explores the best of Zululand including pristine bush in a big five game reserve, a boat trip on the St. Lucia estuary and a visit to a Zulu cultural village for unique insights into the traditional Zulu lifestyle.

<p>Day 1 08h30</p> 	<p>DURBAN TO ZULULAND (Lunch & Dinner)</p> <p>The tour departs from Durban hotels at 08h30 on the 4th June. Head towards Eshowe and into the Umhlatuzi Valley. Visit the great kraal of Senzangakhona as seen in the internationally acclaimed television series “Shaka Zulu”. Experience the traditional Zulu life and demonstrations on etiquette, the social system and traditional dancing. Enjoy the Zulu beer and a festive traditional lunch. Depart Shakaland and in the afternoon arrive at the four star Leopard Mountain Lodge (or similar).</p> <p><i>'Set within an Endangered Species Protected Area, offering peace and tranquillity with friendly hospitality. Our beautiful lodge has the most spectacular views over Zululand, from the river meandering below to the distant Lebombo Mountains.'</i></p> <p>In the late afternoon there is a open vehicle game drive with a specialist bush guide and dinner is included and taken back at the lodge restaurant.</p> <p>Overnight: Leopard Mountain Lodge or similar</p>
<p>Distance</p>	<p>Durban to Leopard Mountain via Shakaland: 360km</p>
<p>Day 2</p> 	<p>Depart for Durban (Breakfast & Lunch)</p> <p>An early start and there there is another open vehicle game drive before returning the lodge for a late breakfast. Check out by 10h00 and travel via Mtubatuba to the town of St Lucia, the gateway to the recently declared St Lucia World Heritage Site - an area of inspiring natural beauty. This 60 km long estuary lies parallel to the sea and is flanked by mangrove swamps, dune forests, woodland and open grasslands. The area is rich with hippos, crocodiles and birdlife. A boat ride up the estuary provides a wonderful window into this complex and fascinating system.</p> <p>A light lunch will be taken in the town of St Lucia.</p> <p>Travel back to Durban where the tour ends on the 5th June at +- 16h30.</p>
<p>Distance</p>	<p>Hluhluwe via St Lucia to Durban +- 390km</p>
